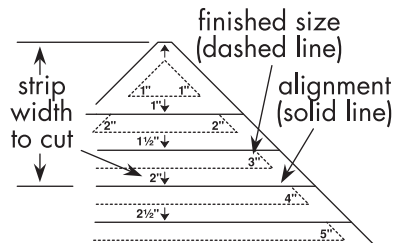


# Companion Angle Cutting Instructions

The finished size of the base of the triangle.  
The numbers down the center are the width of the strip.  
Example: To cut a triangle with a finished base of 4", cut a 2 1/2" strip. Fig. 1.

### Instructions for use:

1. Cut a strip of fabric the desired width.
2. Align the top of the tool with the top of the strip. The bottom of the strip will align with a solid line on the tool. Fig. 2.
3. Cut on both sides of the tool for the first cut.
4. Rotate the tool so the tip is pointing down on the strip. Cut again. Fig. 3.
5. Rotate the tool so the top of the tool is aligned at the top of the strip. Cut again.

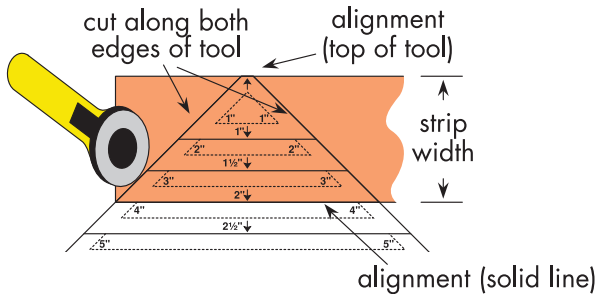
